Rendez-vous on 1 June, in the most beautiful square in Paris, for a day of scrutineering, where the public can come along and admire cars from a bygone era and chat to the crews throughout this exceptional day.

99 crews at the start: an absolute record!

The 20th RALLYE DES PRINCESSES RICHARD MILLE has been full since the end of last September. Even better, this anniversary edition sees the absolute record number of participants, with no less than 99 crews on the start line! Among them several crews who have already won the event, such as that of CAROLE GRATZMULLER and ELISA NOEMIE LAURENT (Chevrolet Corvette Stingray n°56) who between them have chalked up no less than 6 victories! Also among the favourites PATRICIA BERTAPELLE, (1969 Austin Healey MK1) three times winner in the mixed crews category (that hasn't been run for over 7 years) and ADELINA PAQUIERS and HELENA EUVRARD, victorious last year in Biarritz and so the title holders aboard their impressive Ford Cobra n°100.

Audrey Marnay, 'godmother' of the event

With the RALLYE DES PRINCESSES RICHARD MILLE also being an event of glamour and beauty, this 20th edition will have as 'godmother' the actress and model AUDREY MARNAY, a committed car enthusiast, who will take part for the first time aboard her 1971 Mercedes Pagode 280 SL n°34, that she acquired 20 years ago while working in New York.

Wives of champions and a young champion...

Among the participants of the 20th RALLYE DES PRINCESSES RICHARD MILLE there are also wives of champions, such as SÉVERINE LOEB (Porsche 911 S Nr.70), wife of nine-times WRC champion Sébastien Loeb and LINDA MORSELLI (Porsche 356 Nr.2), the Italian model who shares her life with double Formula 1 World Champion and 24H du Mans winner, the Spaniard Fernando Alonso.

At 20 years old, the young American champion AURORA STRAUSS is the same age as the RALLYE DES PRINCESSES RICHARD MILLE and has been called up by the event's title sponsor to share this adventure over the most scenic roads France has to offer. (Porsche 356 Nr.1)

THE ROUTE AT A GLANCE

Two days in Saint-Tropez

The 20th edition of the RALLYE DES PRINCESSES RICHARD MILLE gets under way early on the morning of 2 June from the Place Vendôme for 5 days of competition over 1600 kilometres of the most beautiful scenery France has to offer, with night stops at BEAUVAL (2/06), VICHY (3/06) and AIX-LES-BAINS (4/06), before arriving in style on the Côte d'Azur with two days in SAINT-TROPEZ (5-6/06), finishing on Thursday 6 June with the GRAND PRIX DE SAINT-TROPEZ, a final loop of 300 km, stopping off at the Château Saint-Martin in Taradeau, birthplace of the Paris St Raphaël Féminin, before the final podium in the famous Place des Lices. The gala soiree and price giving will be held in the middle of the vineyards of the Domaine de BERTAUD BELIEU in Gassin.
