After checking with all the teams and main sponsors, the organizers of the Richard Mille Princesses' Rally have decided to postpone the event until June 2021.

The global pandemic brought on by the Covid-19 continues to ravage the world's population, prompting the organizers of the **Richard Mille Princesses' Rally** to survey this year's participants on whether to postpone the event to ensure optimal conditions in every respect. After a completely transparent inquiry with those enrolled as well as our main sponsors, the consensus was to move the 21st edition of this rally to June 2021.
